



## YEAR 7 LITERACY AND NUMERACY CATCH -UP PREMIUM STRATEGIES 2019- 20

The Literacy and Numeracy 'Catch-Up Premium' provides schools with additional funding to support Year 7 students who did not achieve the appropriate standard in tests for English and/or Mathematics at the end of Key Stage 2.

The 'Catch-Up Premium' received for the academic year 2019-20 is £16,207 and is being used to fund the following strategies and interventions:

Strategy	Detail
Bonus Maths Class	Year 7 classes have 5 sets instead of 4 enabling weakest to be taught in a small class. 8 teacher periods + 10% PPA = 9 teacher periods.
Lexia	Emphasis is placed on phonics, spelling and word attack skills. It provides the building blocks for reading fluency and comprehension for those students entering below ARE( age related expectations)
Transition workshops	English/ Maths teacher leads series of workshops with below ARE target students in summer term.
Peer tutor reading	Year 9 students assigned to read regularly with identified Year 6 students. (transition)
Mymaths access	All students given mymaths logins with an online programme of activities to boost basic numeracy skills.
LSA support in some classes to support reading and writing across the curriculum	In some classes ASA used to support reading and writing and numeracy across the curriculum
Revamp of library resources for lower level readers	More differentiated resources for lower level readers/ reading logs and dedicated reading time.
Staff training - reading across the curriculum and Tier 2 vocabulary	Training of staff to ensure reading and Tier 2 vocabulary skills are taught within each curriculum area
